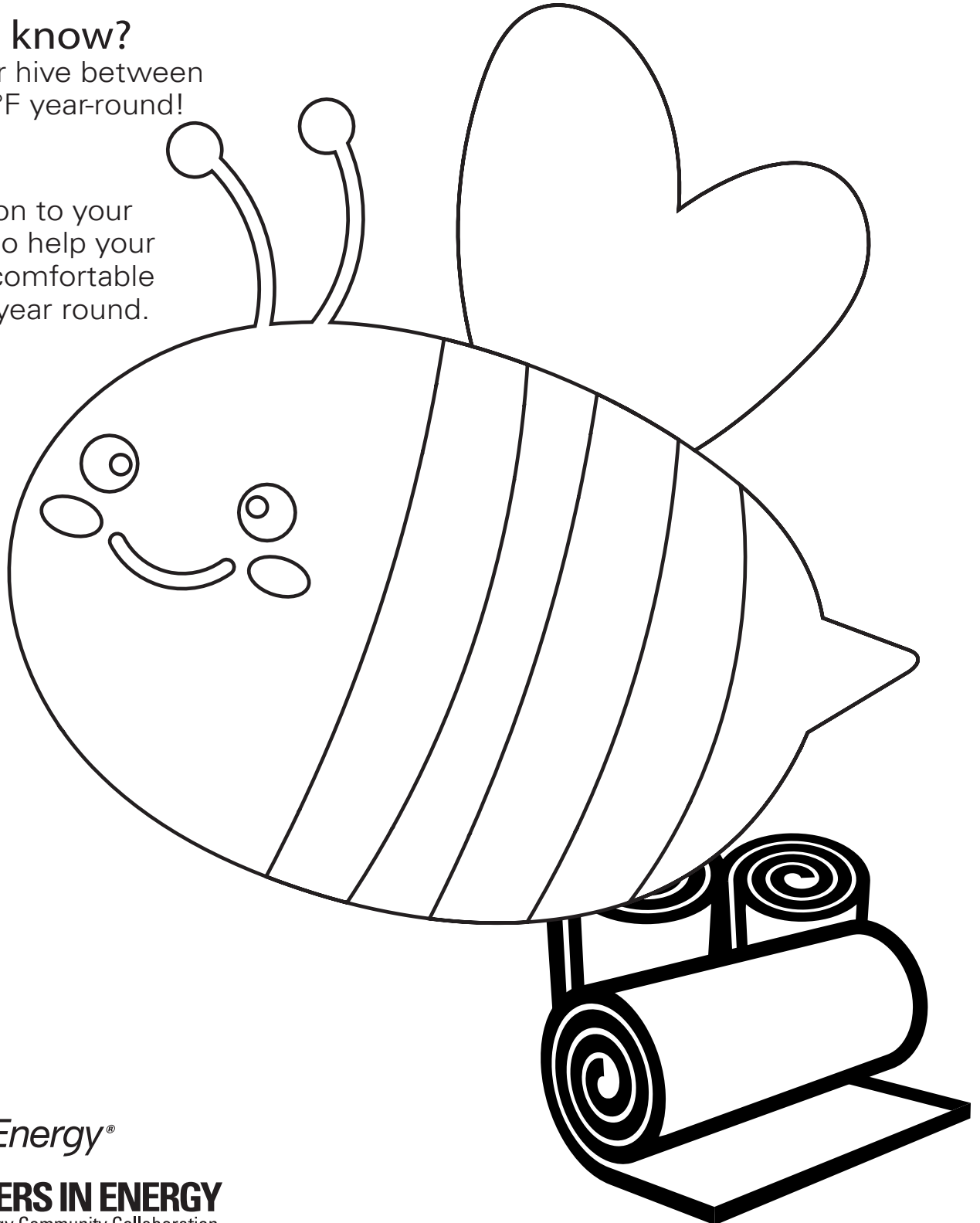


INDUSTRIOUS HONEYBEE

temperature year round.



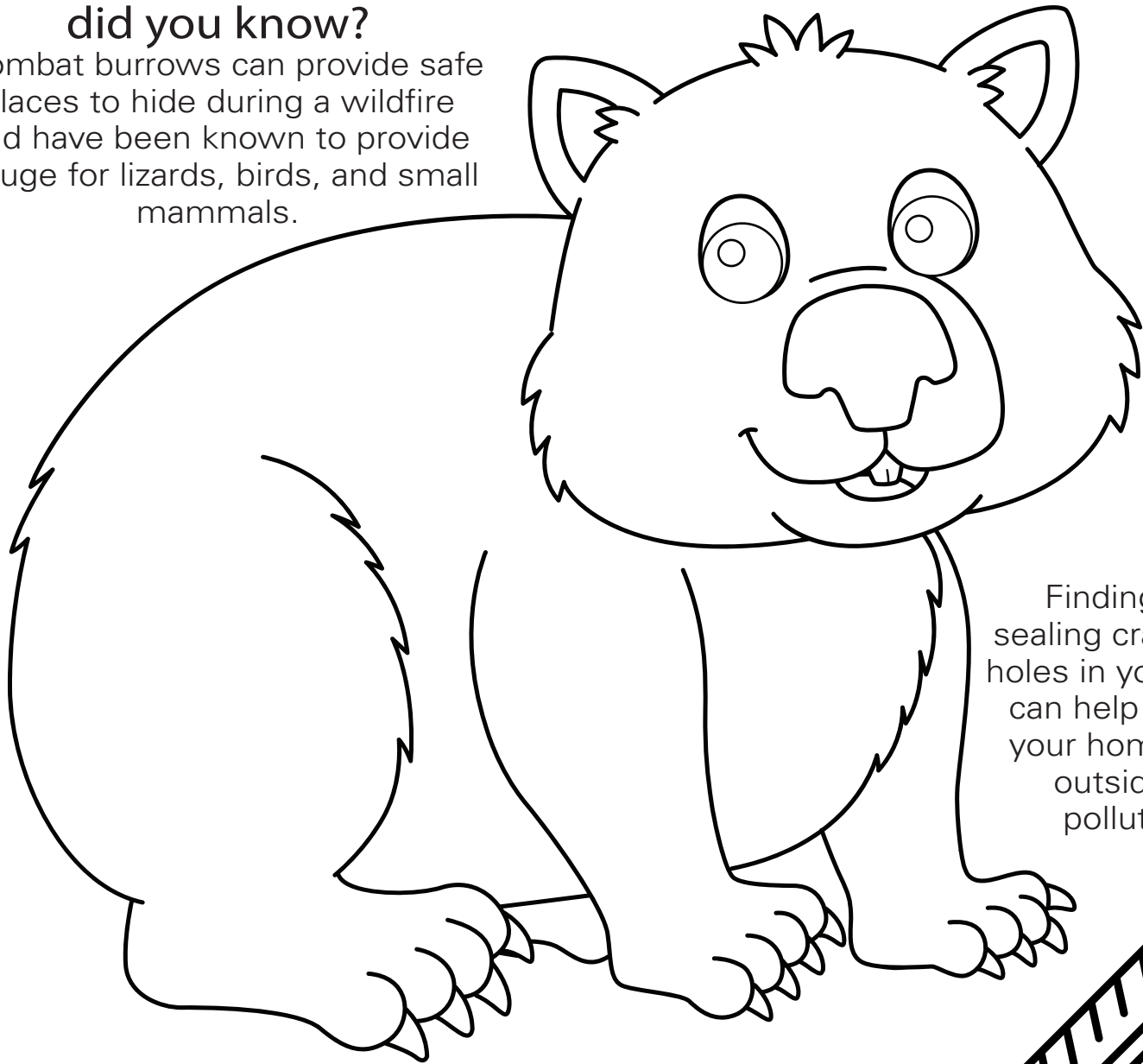

forms, like rolls or spray foam!

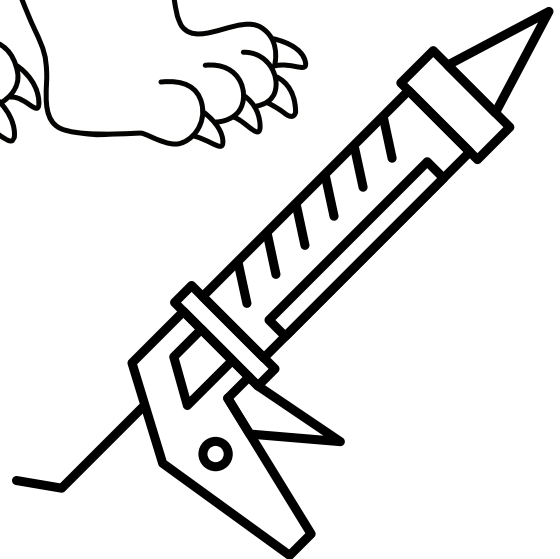
RESILIENT WOMBAT

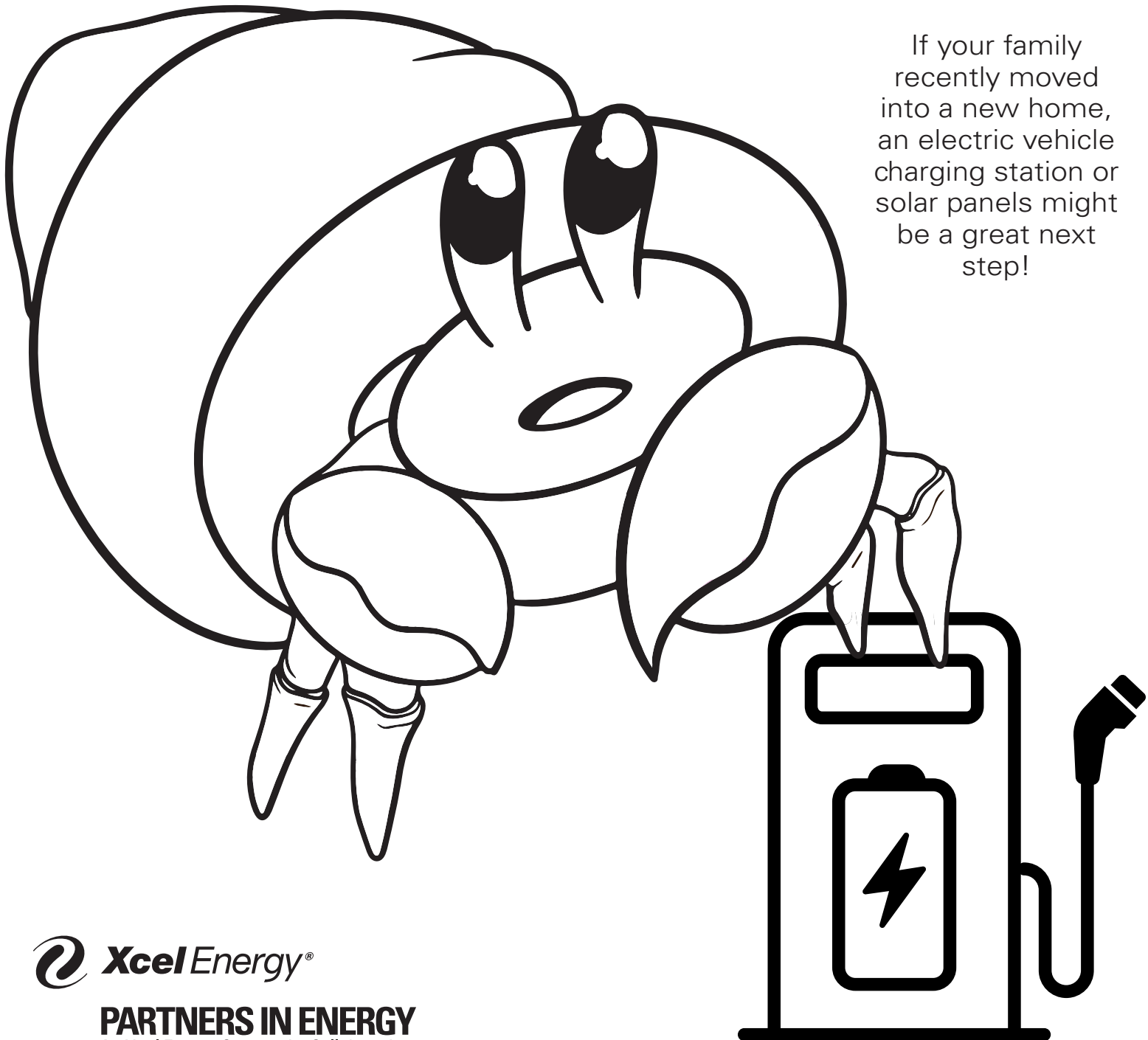
Caulking guns are used to seal cracks and small holes in your home.
